You can also live out your "Olympic gymnast" dreams on the floor mat—hooked to a harness, you'll learn moves like the walkover, handspring, and flip (with a little help from a waist-lifting pulley). ### SCAVENGER HUNT

It may be dorky, but we prefer a coed scavenger hunt to the tradition of separate bachelor and bachelorette parties. Two Florida options: **The South Beach Scavenger Hunt** and **Southernmost Scavenger Hunt** create 15- to 20-clue scavenger hunts around Miami and Key West, respectively; the same company operates both tours. In addition to the basic hunts, there are also chauffeured hunts, photo

scavenger hunts (with Polaroid cameras), and even "cruise" hunts where you tool around town in open-air electric cars.

The company can create a customized hunt and even write questions based on places that are significant to you—like the movie theater where you went on your first date, or your favorite bar.
